The Beautiful Trap-Navigating the Dark Side of Lip Filler

Proper aseptic techniques should be followed to avoid infection, and understanding the lip area's anatomy is vital to prevent complications, especially concerning vascular anatomy. Finally, aesthetic considerations should be taken into account, such as whether the goal is reshaping or rejuvenation of the lips. Most importantly, relatively safe injection techniques for lip fillers should be used.
