



Prof. Brigitte Dréno is Dermato-Oncologist. She is also Vice President to the Scientific and technical Culture of Nantes University France. She leads a research project included in the investments for the future hospital-university research in health (RHU) focusing in burn and regenerative dressing. She works also the field of melanoma, drug induced cutaneous adverse events and microbiome and acne . She is the director of a research team INSERM INCITE.

She is Founder member of the European Association of Dermato Oncology (EADO), past president of the French Society of Dermatology and French college of dermatology teachers, Treasurer of the International League of Dermatological Societies (ILDS). In addition, member of AAD, ADA, International Society for Cutaneous Lymphomas, Skin Cancer Foundation. She has published over 900 articles referenced in PubMed (H Index 83), participated to the redaction of chapters of several books. She built the first GMP cell and gene therapy hospital unit in France in Nantes.

She is an Editorial Board Member of JEADV, Acta Dermatology, European Journal of Cancer Prevention, International Journal of women's Dermatology and Editor of the quarterly medical review (La Presse Medical). She has obtained several awards such as the Award of ILDS, the Price of the International Society for Cutaneous Lymphomas, the Price of the French victories of medicine. She has been granted to the grade of Chevalier of the Order of the Legion of Honour by the President of the French Republic as well as Chevalier in the Order of Academic Palms of Nantes' s University and has been elected recently member of the French Academy of Medecine.
