Research and studies in dermatology:

• Epidemiology of zoonotic dermatophyte infections in Scotland:

Retrospective epidemiological study investigating prevalence of all zoophilic dermatophyte infections in Scotland in the period 1996-2006, comparing with 1981 data. Techniques used included database and statistical analysis. The findings were presented (oral) at the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology meeting in Paris, France in 2008 and published in the journal of *Clinical and Experimental Dermatology*.

• <u>Immunohistochemistry research in Skin Cancer Unit, Western Infirmary,</u> <u>Glasgow:</u>

Antigen retrieval on mice models looking into the expression or loss of *P*-*TEN* and *fos* with as a consequence the development of keratoacanthoma or squamous cell carcinoma. Techniques learned included immunofluorescence and antigen retrieval.

• <u>Study into the assessment and knowledge of gloves and latex allergy in a tertiary</u> <u>Hospital.</u>

Research was conducted into the knowledge and recognition of allergies and the appropriate use of gloves in healthcare settings. The findings were published as an original article in the journal *Clinical and Experimental Dermatology*.

• Patients' awareness of the flammability hazard of paraffin-based products:

Questionnaire-based research conducted across three centres showing poor patient awareness of the flammability hazard of paraffin-based products. The findings were published as an article in the *British Journal of Dermatology*.

<u>Patch testing of stoma patients presenting with peri-stomal dermatitis:</u>

More than 120 patients patch tested across two large centres and analysis of the relevance of patch testing in this group. The findings of the study were published as an original article in the *British Journal of Dermatology*.

• <u>Repetitive UV provocation of all patients with hydroa vacciniforme in the North</u> <u>West of England.</u>

This study was conducted to ascertain the threshold of UV provocation among 11 patients with hydroa vacciniforme. The findings showed that repetitive provocation is needed to induce the clinical lesions, in contrary to most of the reported literature.

• <u>Patch testing patients presenting with vulval dermatoses:</u>

Retrospective and prospective analysis of the results of patch testing in this group leading to standardisation of patch testing. The findings of the study were presented as a poster at the European Society of Contact Dermatitis meeting in Strasbourg, France in 2010 and published in the journal of *Clinical and Experimental Dermatology*.

• <u>Study in the role of urine exposure and peristomal lichen sclerosus:</u>

This was a cohort study performed in the combined skin/stoma clinic looking at the rate and cause of peristomal lichen sclerosus and its relationship to urine exposure. The findings of the study were published in the *British Journal of Dermatology*.

• Eczema severity assessment and quality of life in patients undergoing patch testing:

This was a study performed at the contact dermatitis unit in Manchester assessing the eczema severity and quality of life in patients undergoing patch testing using the EASI score and the DLQI. Correlation of both scores was assessed. The findings were presented at the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology meeting in Gothenburg, Sweden in 2010.

• <u>Comparative study in the use of topical anaesthetics in laser procedures:</u>

During my laser work at the Laser department in Manchester I was instrumental in designing and performing a comparative study on the use of three common topical anaesthtics in laser procedures. This was a double-blinded study. The findings of the study were presented at the international meeting of Laser Europe in London in 2012 and published in the journal of *Journal of Cutaneous and Aesthetic Surgery*.

I was involved in a study comparing the efficacy of the three main Q-switched lasers (532, 755, and 1064 nm) in the treatment of naevus of Ota looking to identify the optimal wavelength, parameters, clearance, and recurrence rates.
