Bio:

Since 2012, Dr. Patrick Huang has served as Executive Director of the Taiwanese Dermatological Association (TDA), where he previously served as Director from 2006 to 2012. Dr. Huang was appointed Department Chair of Dermatology at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital-Kaohsiung in 2002. (CGMHK). In 2002, during his tenure as department chair, he developed Taiwan's first and only psoriasis daycare center. In addition, attempting to strike a balance between medical and cosmetic dermatology development during his tenure as department chair, he launched the first aesthetic dermatology service at CGMHK in 2003.

Before Dr. Huang altered the Taiwanese Dermatology Congress meeting structure in 2012, industries were the sole providers of cosmetic procedure training courses. Dr. Huang launched the Taiwanese Dermatology Aesthetic Conference (TDAC) in 2013 to provide English-language neutral continuing medical education to local and Asian dermatologists and aesthetic practitioners. Because this event was such a huge success, he was invited to organize IMCAS Asia in 2014 and has been in charge of doing so ever since.

In addition to founding the Taiwan Society for Dermatologic and Aesthetic Surgery (TSDAS) in 2016 to represent and unite skin surgeons, Dr. Huang was also certified as a Certified Mentor/Host of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery's (ASDS) International Traveling Mentorship Program (ITMP) in 2018 to initiate international collaboration. Only three Taiwanese dermatologists are involved in this educational project. Dr. Huang updated the dermatology residency training program in 2017 to provide a more significant emphasis on aesthetic dermatology and skin surgery. Because of this, the Residency Review Committee (RRC) of Taiwan's Ministry of Education shifted dermatology from Internal Medicine to Surgery.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, he founded the Cyber Conference of Aesthetic Dermatology and Skin Surgery in APAC to satisfy the needs of regional practitioners with online, highly interactive medical education in these time zones. Dr. Huang was recognized as a pioneer in extending dermatologists' responsibilities in Asia. He was elected board president of Kaohsiung American School for 2016–18.
