From 1998 to 2000, he served as Attending Physician in Dermatology at the Yung Kang Veterans Hospital, Tainan, Taiwan, and from 2000 to 2003, as Attending Physician in Dermatology at Veterans General Hospital Kaohsiung, Taiwan. He established the HSU Nai-Jen Dermatologic Clinic in 2003.

During his distinguished career, Dr. HSU has been honoured with awards in Taiwan including the “Outstanding clinical teacher of dermatology” award from the Veterans Hospital Kaohsiung in 1998, and the “Outstanding paper” award from the Skin Education Research and Development Foundation in 1999, “Best International Collaboration - Gold Paper” award from PRS Global Open for the year 2016.
