Title: Clinical pearls and implications sharing for lower face and neck

cosmetic treatments

The lower third plays an important role for the attractive appearance of the face. A well-defined jawline and ideal cervico-mandibular angle are desirable in men and women, showing the sign of youth.

By using injectables, physicians can restore and reshape patient's lower third without surgery. The aesthetic goal of the rejuvenation approach is to redefine the mandibular angle and line. Besides, neck region is often neglected. Ideally, early intervention of this region yields satisfactory results.

In my speech, I will share my personal experiences of combination therapy for treating customer's lower third for aesthetic goal.
