

Challenging Periorbital Cases — Comprehensive Non-surgical Strategies using MERZ Portfolio

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The periorbital area is challenging and prone to unsatisfactory results because of its complex anatomy, dynamic features, and thin skin. It is not an area where one single recipe would satisfy the needs of different patients presenting with either tear troughs, eye bags, wrinkles, upper eyelid hollowing, eyebrow ptosis, or a combination of the above. Proper pre-treatment assessment to identify the underlying anatomical changes and tailoring treatments with fillers of suitable rheology, neuromodulation, and customized tissue tightening is crucial to natural results. Dr. TSENG will share his minimally-invasive approach combining Micro-focus ultrasound, hyaluronic acid fillers of different consistency, and botulinum toxin type A to treat difficult periorbital cases.
