Lipoatrophy and volume loss over upper eyelids are now recognized as signs of aging.

These changes will lead to deep hollowing of the upper lids with increased upper eyelid show and a skeletonized orbital rim appearance. Traditional blepharoplasty does little to rejuvenate patients with lipoatrophy and skeletonization. This population requires volume restoration instead of soft tissue removal.

There are many different kinds of hollowing, not all kinds of sunken upper eyelids will be suitable for the treatment. In this lecture I will talk about patient selections, treatment methods and considerations.
